
This guide walks you through the basic functionality of the Learning Center. Check back often as content is regularly added! Mobile Friendly!

There are multiple ways to access the Learning Center depending on your credentials:

Option 1: Accessing the Learning Center via the Member Portal, not the Claims portal (for members who have Member portal credentials)

- 1. From the caringcomm.org website, select Learning Center button
- 2. It will bring you to a log in page
- 3. Self-Identify which category you fall into based on the descriptors for each








- If you have access to the Caring Communities Member Portal, select the Single Sign on option, where you will log into the Member Portal and be brought to the Learning Center Home Page. Follow the prompts
- If you do not have access to the Caring Communities Member Portal, select Create New Account. Upon review, you will receive an email confirming your access. Once confirmed, you will continue to enter via the Learning Center login button in the future.



- Intro to Risk Management: Videos that introduce key aspects of the partnership with Caring Communities and the core principals of risk management. Designed for newly appointed risk management liaisons and those seeing a refresher on risk management fundamentals.
- **Training Courses**: Series of short video courses designed to provide you with foundational to advanced knowledge on various topics. Most video clips are 3-5 minutes in length.


Breakdown of each Area


1. Catalog/All Content

 You can refine your search from the right navigation bar by Category or Format based on a topic you are interested in. You can also Find a Course using the Find a course search function. *note if you have checked a category to conduct a search, uncheck it prior to searching another topic.

2. Intro To Risk Management


- The Overview tab will provide an overview of the course
- Take Course will bring you directly to the components that make up the course: videos, related resources, toolkits, etc.
- For this course it is recommended you watch each of the videos in sequential order. You can, however, select the ones you want to watch by selecting the title and selecting Start





3. Webinars

- From the Go to Catalog link on the webinar home page, you can view an archived webinar by Category or Key Word.
- Select the webinar you wish to watch, review the overview and select Take Course.
- For all Webinars, there are also accompanying Power Point slides titled Related Resources that you can pull up to view, print or download.



4. Training Courses


- Training courses are organized by topic. You can skip around to the topic you are interested in learning,




5. Toolkits (found under the Catalog dropdown)
